

I really liked the first one but thought the change of format would ruin the second game. It definitely changed how the game was played with more focus on exploring. It changed things but I wasn't disappointed. It continues from part one but takes place in a different location.

Pros- Good story, atmosphere, voice and sound, continues where the first one left off and ends the storyline.

Cons- Interface, less ominous atmosphere than first game, looks and feels old

If you liked the first one this is a must buy! I really enjoyed it.. An incredibly well put-together game, with refreshing dialogue, music, graphics, and mystery. The story is very fleshed out and there is a lot of information packed into such a tiny game. Many people complain about the length; some even saying it took them 20 minutes to beat. Well if it took you 20 minutes you're FAR from experiencing the full game. I exhausted almost all dialogue options, and searched everything around the house, made my decision thoughtfully on who to kill, and it took me a little under 2 hours. I don't believe game length matters as long as it was the CORRECT length. Now, while Postmortem DID end a bit early, the length was fairly well established and the game ended when it should have, more or less.

The characters have rich and thought-out stories and have realistic responses and what you say seems to matter. I would've liked more options and more people, though as far as a dialogue-driven game goes, Postmortem does what it sets out to do very well. Postmortem has incredible potential and I hope to see a sequel in the near future. I wouldn't be upset if they released DLC (fairly priced, of course) which consisted of other houses and events with the same premise: just more scenarios.

It was very enjoyable to play through and listen to each character's story and that's saying a lot because I don't usually enjoy games like this, and lately my attention span has been getting shorter and shorter, so it's rare a game captures my attention for this long nowadays. But alas, Postmortem did, and for good reason, it's a great game and if you take your time playing through it and actually make a thoughtful decision, there can be a good amount of impact and intensity to it which makes it a good experience overall.

I recommend buying this game if you like murder mysteries (even though it's somewhat backwards since you're the one doing the killing), dialogue and story-driven games, rich characters, charming graphics and soundtrack, and an engaging story overall. I would also recommend waiting until it goes on sale if you're worried about the length of it, as \$6.99 is a bit much for a 2 hour game for some people.

7/10. I strongly recommend skipping this chapter. The puzzles on Nessa's story arc are un-intuitive and very frustrating. I had to look up how to solve them. It's like the developers didn't play-test this.. How is the Don not tweeting about this game yet? By far, the most entertaining 12 minutes of my life. It sounds like a good idea on paper, but the execution leaves something to be desired. You can barely rotate the environments at all, controls are poor and fiddly, and it's not always clear what you have to find or do. It also crashed on me a couple times.

Also, the story for this game was written by and for kindergateners on acid. The princess turns into a monster for some reason but is then kidnapped by aliens. You want to go after them but you must get a map from some pirates and gas from a jungle temple. That's as far as I got before it crashed for the second time and I gave up.

It's kind of amusing just because the story is so weird, but I wouldn't spend money on it.

Strongly recommend. There are many features yet to complete but this game has great potential. We need more people to buy this game so that the developer can have funds to complete the game.
